Dear Parishioners,

In recent times we have been told that we should be politically correct in our thinking and especially in our use of language. If the same demands were placed on the Gospels then today's parable might sound very different. It might be interesting to read today's gospel, as we find it in the liturgy, alongside the following version:

"One day, observing judgmental behaviour by morally self-righteous persons, Jesus told this parable:

Two male persons went up to the Temple to pray to their Higher Power. One was a humility-impooverished Pharisee and the other was a marginalized collector of revenue. Believing himself to be of a higher social class, the Pharisee prayed: "Higher Power, I thank you that I am not like other persons: that I am non-waged, morally different, non-goal oriented, or non-monogamous. I am especially thankful that I'm not like this revenue collector who surely tells untruths in order to economically exploit people. In general I'm a great guy. Of course, you already know that!"

The other, standing at the edge of the temple, would not lift his eyes towards his Higher Power (obviously a case of low self-esteem caused by dysfunctional family upbringing). He prayed in a quiet voice: "Lord, please be merciful to me, an exploiter of the masses. I have taken advantage of persons who are differently abled, cerebrally challenged and economically disadvantaged. I beg forgiveness".

Pressing the point, Jesus commented: "The marginalized tax collector kept correct focus and went to his home with the blessing of his Higher Power. For all who are humility-gifted will become self-actualised". And the hearers said, 'what?'
