First of all, I wish to apologise for the delay in publication, due to circumstances outside my control. I extend my appreciation and thanks to the Parish Finance Committee for their professional guidance and support at all times. I am hoping that a statement for the financial year 2013/2014 can be published very shortly; this would give us a more accurate picture of the parish's current financial situation.

While the income from the weekly collections has reduced over the years, and continues to do so, it is very heartening, nevertheless, to report that the main outstanding loan in relation to St Patrick's Church, Dungannon has now been completely repaid. This in itself is an extraordinary achievement, but the fact that it has been cleared within such a short period of time and in the midst of the worst recession in recent decades, is all the more remarkable. I can't ever express sufficiently my sincere gratitude and appreciation to all those, whose generosity and personal sacrifices made this possible. As I have mentioned before on many occasions, it is the Lord who is being honoured and so I trust with all my heart that the same Lord will reward abundantly every person's contribution.



Several years ago we embarked on a parish campaign to improve and upgrade all parish properties and amenities within the whole parish; much of this has been achieved. Very shortly, we will begin the refurbishment of St Malachy's Church, Edendork, which is in great need Sacred Heart of attention. I thank the people of Edendork area for their forbearance. At the moment we don't know the final costing for such work. The parish will also have ongoing financial commitments for the upkeep of the former Convent of Mercy in addition to certain aspects of schools' expenditure that is not fully grant aided by the Department of Education. Therefore, I trust on your continued support for such ongoing costs.

Finally, can I make a gentle plea to those parishioners, who may have neglected their responsibilities in this regard? It is a matter of justice; if everyone pulls their weight to the best of their ability, the burden is made easier for all!
