Dear Parishioners

It is, as always, a great privilege to travel to Lourdes with the Armagh Diocesan Pilgrimage. Gathered here in this holy place, there are over seven hundred pilgrims from many parishes throughout the Archdiocese, from Magherafelt in Co Derry to Drogheda in Co Louth. Among the Dungannon contingent, there are a number of people who have never been to Lourdes before and I have no doubt they will relish the memory of these lovely days for a long time to come.

Since we were here twelve months ago, the town of Lourdes suffered enormously from severe flooding; many of the chapels, including the sanctuary area near the Grotto were completely inundated when the river Gave burst its banks. A huge clean up operation, lasting several weeks, has ensured that pilgrims are able to return once again, and come they have from all over the world. Today Cardinal Brady was chief celebrant at the International Mass when over 28,000 pilgrims gathered in St Pius X underground Basilica. It was truly magnificent.

Our assisted pilgrims are well cared for by a great team of helpers, ably supported by dozens of young people, who come here from various parts of the Archdiocese. Tonight they will have the honour of leading the Torchlight Procession.

On a personal note, I am pleased to bring before Our Lady of Lourdes the intentions of the priests and people of Dungannon Parish, mindful in a particular way of all those parishioners who are sick; those who are weighed down by personal and family worries; young people preparing for exams and the countless other areas of parish life that need Our Lady's protection and guidance. I am remembering too the many people who have died during the past twelve months.

As I look at the statue of Mary, the Mother of God, described by Bernadette as "the Beautiful Lady", I recall the words of the lovely invocation we pray so often, "Oh Mother of the Word Incarnate, do not reject our petitions, but in your clemency, hear and answer them. Amen"
