Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds the disciples that - regardless of how things might appear - they will not be alone, disjoined or disconnected. And Jesus names the reason for that connection as the Advocate, the Spirit of Truth: the Holy Spirit. If there's a prevalent feeling in the western world today, it is probably loneliness. Mother Teresa once referred to loneliness as the greatest affliction of our age. Even at social events, music - though good in itself - can be so loud as to inhibit conversation.

Likewise in the workplace - a major arena for social interaction - the focus can be more on efficiency and profits than people and human relationships. Even within family life, it is difficult for people to be together. Everyone is doing "their own thing". Valid as that might be, the overall effect may be to heighten that sense of being more individualistic, more isolated and more alone.

Maybe that's just the way things are going to be. Maybe we are powerless to change this manner of life and living. If so, the words of Jesus are even more significant when he says we are not alone and when he assures us that he is with us. Yet, to recognise the Lord's presence in the events of daily living, it is essential that I reflect and spend quiet time alone in the presence of God and allow his Spirit speak to my heart. God is present in silence. God speaks to us through his Word.

As we approach the great Feast of Pentecost, we are reminded of the extraordinary gift and the limitless power of the Holy Spirit at work in the world. The Spirit is nothing less than God himself crossing the great divide and making his dwelling place in the hearts of humankind. He comes in many forms and touches us in vastly varied ways. May we reach out in trust and leave ourselves open and receptive to his influence so that the Holy Spirit will strengthen our hope and give our lives new direction.
