Dear Parishioners,

On this Pentecost Sunday it is appropriate that we should congratulate the 179 young people and adults who were confirmed in this parish last week-end; may the Holy Spirit remain always with them and help them to be true followers of Jesus Christ in all that they do and say. We compliment their parents and families and all who assist them on their faith journey. We recall the words addressed to the parents and god parents on the occasion of the child's baptism: "*You must make it your constant care to bring them up in the practice of the faith.*" Essentially this means that family values and personal example will leave the most lasting impression of all.

A sincere word of thanks to the principals, teachers and staff members of all the schools who helped prepare the young people for the Sacrament of Confirmation. We are indebted to them for their personal dedication and hard work. At the present time when some of the familiar structures and traditional values in family and Church are under threat, we rely on the help of the Holy Spirit. Many people are trying to retain the customs and standards that shaped their lives in the past. Like the disciples in the Upper Room we are sometimes fearful of what is happening all around us. Overwhelmed by change, we wonder what the future will bring.

But the message of Pentecost assures us that we are not alone. The Spirit can be our guiding light, giving us the courage to face up to problems, helping us to discover personal resources and the vision to see new ways ahead. Today we ask God to come into our lives and to strengthen us with his Spirit so that we will be his voice where the sick need healing, the hungry need feeding and the distressed need comforting.
