Corpus Christi

Dear Parishioners,

It was a troubled man who came to see the local priest. His story was typical: one of a large family, born of hardworking parents who had performed an emotional and economic miracle to educate their family. The parents took pride in their children's achievements, when life, work and greater opportunities brought them away from the little farm.

The mother had died a few years back. The son brought the sad news that his father had taken seriously ill and had to go to hospital. His question to the priest – would it be a mortal sin on his part if he only visited his father a few times a year, and stayed for less than thirty minutes each time?

Fortunately, none of the above actually happened. But lack of appreciation for parents does mirror how we often treat the Lord, present to us in the Holy Mass. As the old phrase puts it: "Eaten bread is soon forgotten". We can take so much for granted.

Corpus Christi was established as a feast to restore honour to the presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament and to atone for inflicted neglect. It is surely a necessary feast for each of us to mark. Reducing the Eucharist to obligation, even travelling further for shorter and quicker Masses – speaks volumes of the emptiness within and more than a touch of ingratitude.
