Dear Parishioners,

On this Sunday when the “gift of wisdom” is being extolled, I offer two pieces for your reflection. The first is a series of thoughts from “Parents to their Children”:

“We gave you life, but we cannot live it for you. We can teach you things, but we cannot make you learn. We can give you directions, but we cannot be there to lead you. We can take you to church, but we cannot make you believe. We can give you love, but we cannot force it upon you. We can advise you about friends, but we cannot choose them for you. We can teach you to share, but we cannot make you unselfish. We can teach you respect, but we cannot force you to show honour. We can teach you right from wrong, but we cannot always decide for you. We can warn you about sin, but we cannot make you walk with God. We can tell you how to live, but we cannot give you eternal life.”

The second piece is taken from the wishes and prayers of *Johann Wolfgang von Goethe*, one of Germany’s greatest literary scholars:

“May you always have:
Health enough to make work a pleasure.
Wealth enough to support your needs.
Strength to battle with difficulties and overcome them.
Grace enough to confess your sins and forsake them.
Patience enough to toil until some good is accomplished.
Charity enough to see some good in your neighbour.
Love enough to make you useful and helpful to others.
Faith enough to make real the things of God.
Hope enough to remove all anxious fears concerning the future.”

And finally, in this month of July there’s a story told of two Irish labourers who went to work in London. They were new to traffic light, not unlike people in Dungannon getting used to new traffic lights! Anyway, having watched the transient amber and the more enduring green, one said to the other, “they don’t allow the Protestants much time to get across”.
