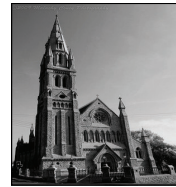

Dear Parishioners,

Many people in this parish express their respect for the dead in a variety of ways: remembering anniversaries; including their names on the Parish Dead List; attending to their graves etc. All of these are admirable in terms of upholding our Catholic tradition.

People may have noticed, however, that the number of deceased whose anniversaries are recalled each week-end, especially in St Patrick's, Dungannon, has expanded out of proportion. This is due to the fact that the names of deceased persons are transferred automatically from the previous year. In effect, this means that names have been carried forward for maybe thirty years or more. On occasion, there can be as many as eighty names announced. Some of the people mentioned may have no direct connection with the parish - they may have been people who lived elsewhere, but had a family member living in Dungannon at the time of their death.

I have discussed this matter with the Parish Pastoral Council; in order to streamline the situation, I would like to propose that from First Sunday of Advent - 30 November 2014:

- Parishioners take responsibility for deciding who should be remembered.
  - No longer will names be carried forward automatically.
  - The recently deceased will be prayed for until the Month's Memory.
  - If parishioners wish to have a deceased person prayed for publicly they should submit the person's details (name and date of anniversary) in writing to the Curates' House two weeks in advance or by e mail to the Parish Office.
- Some families may wish to have the deceased person prayed for; others may wish to have Mass offered for that person.
- The recommended diocesan stipend is £10.
  - When a priest accepts a Mass stipend he is obliged to fulfil the obligation.
  - If he cannot offer the Mass himself, he will forward the stipend and the name of the deceased person to another priest, or usually to a Missionary Order / Society.
  - If a parishioner wishes to have a deceased person prayed for, without Mass, a donation is optional.
