BLESSING OF GRAVES IN CARLAND ROAD CEMETERIES 2015

This Sunday, we celebrate the annual blessing of graves in Dungannon and we pray for all loved ones who have been laid to rest in our cemeteries, especially those who have died since this time last year. Respect for our dead and care for their places of burial is an important part of our Catholic tradition and parishioners are to be complimented on the way in which they attend their family plots at this time of year. Again, I encourage all parishioners to continue to maintain the different graveyards in our parish after the annual blessings and dispose of dead flowers, etc. in a proper way, by taking them home or putting them in the skip.

Those attending the blessing of graves in Dungannon this weekend are asked to cooperate with the stewards and with the PSNI who will be present on the day. Once again, we are very grateful to Drumglass High School for the use of their carpark. The proceeds of the Cemetery Gate collection, which will be taken up at the entrances, will go to maintenance of the cemeteries.

FORMAL INVESTITURE WITH THE PALLIUM

Pope Francis will bless and present the *Pallium* (an ecclesiastical vestment bestowed on the Archbishop by the Pope as a symbol of the jurisdiction delegated to them by the HOLY SEE to Archbishop Eamon Martin after consecrated Mass in St Peter's Basilica, Rome on the Feast of St Peter and St Paul, 29th June. Archbishop Eamon will return to Armagh for the formal investiture by Archbishop Charles Brown, Apostolic Nuncio to Ireland, in the presence of bishops and representatives from the nine dioceses in the ecclesiastical province of Armagh in St Patrick's Cathedral Armagh at 7pm Mass on Saturday 4th July 2015.
