Dear Parishioners,

On 8th September past Archbishop Eamon Martin launched the Diocesan Plan "*Share the Joy of the Gospel*" in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh. It was a very special occasion with representatives from all parishes in the archdiocese, including Dungannon. The diocesan plan outlines a programme of pastoral initiatives that will be implemented over the next five years in every parish and will touch many aspects of our faith. It has been particularly inspired by the teachings and writings of Pope Francis and his constant challenge to "get out into the market place and share the Good News with joy and hope". It will focus on three main areas described briefly as (i) Mission and Outreach (ii) Spirit-filled Worship (iii) Catechesis – (Understanding our Faith) As you glance through the recommendations for each of these three areas, you will notice that our own Parish Pastoral Council has already embarked on a number of similar initiatives.

There are some copies of the Diocesan Plan available in each of the churches and it can be viewed on the parish website; you are also encouraged to take one of the prayer cards and say the prayer often.

I want to compliment everyone who was involved in last Sunday's ceremony of Dedication for St Malachy's Church, Edendork. It was a truly joyful occasion and a great credit to the hard work and co-operation of many people. Cardinal Brady was particularly impressed with the involvement of all the children and young people, who did a great job. Photographs of the celebrations can be seen on the parish web page; images can also be viewed by following the Face book and Twitter links on the same web page. I would encourage parishioners from other areas of the parish to drop in to St Malachy's, which is open every day and to visit the Grotto in the graveyard.

Copies of the Edendork Commemorative booklet are available from the parish office.

The Parish Pastoral Council has been extremely busy in preparing for the Parish Mission which will take place from 18th to 25th October. A full programme of ceremonies and devotions has been planned for all the churches in the parish and I am confident this mission will be a time of special grace and blessing for all of us. Please continue to pray that the Lord will do great things in helping us to avail of this occasion to appreciate and celebrate the richness of our Catholic faith.
