Dear Parishioners,

In every generation there have been members of the Christian community who made the Gospel real and alive in a variety of ways. Today we honour them. We think of those whose stories are well known: Saints of Ireland like Patrick, Brigid, Colmcille, Malachy and Oliver Plunkett; European Saints like Vincent de Paul, Therese of Lisieux, Jean Vianney and biblical saints like John, Paul, Stephen and litanies of other popular men and women renowned for their outstanding qualities. Many of these saints have their own feast days when they are honoured and revered.

Today, however, is also a day for remembering the multitude of people who, in the context of their ordinary lives, found themselves in situations that required extraordinary actions *for* and *because of* their Christian faith. They may not have done anything spectacular that warranted special recognition, but they were people of quiet fidelity and humble lifestyle, who remind us of that to which we are called, and what it is possible for us to be.

One of the prayers of the Mass states it well: "You renew the Church in every age by raising up men and women outstanding in holiness, living witnesses of your unchanging love. They inspire us by their heroic lives, and help us by their constant prayers to be the living sign of your saving power." (*Preface of Holy Men and Women II*). We too are called to be living witnesses of God's unchanging love, living signs of his saving power.

Many of you do that already in ways that perhaps you don't even suspect. Many of you give very generously of yourselves to ensure that our parish continues to be a place where a Christian community can grow in faith, hope and love. That was well demonstrated at the opening ceremony of the Parish Mission two weeks ago. Many parents make huge sacrifices in order to hand on to their children a vision of life that is informed by faith in Jesus Christ.

The quiet humble heroism of people who do extraordinary things in the context of ordinary lives is what 'renews the Church in every age'. We call them saints because they were 'living witnesses of God's unchanging love'. May future generations say the same about us.

INDULGENCES FOR HOLY SOULS

From 12 o'clock noon on 1 Nov until midnight on 2 Nov, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed. Confession can be made any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 Nov. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 Nov to 8 Nov.

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1 Nov to 8 Nov.
