Dear Parishioners,

November is a month to remember; we remember those who have passed on to the fullness of life. Aware that death has journeyed with us from the moment of conception, we remember those who have been invited to come home completely to the God who loved them in to life and now allows them to see clearly and totally the immensity of that love.

November is a month which invites us to value and appreciate the importance of time. We have but one life and no moment can ever be repeated. Consider the following two reflections by unknown authors:

First I was dying to finish primary school and start college. Then I was dying to finish college and start working. Then I was dying to marry and have children. Then I was dying for my children to grow old enough for school so I could go back to work. Then I was dying to retire. Now I am dying, and I have suddenly realised that I forgot to live.

And another reminder of the value of each moment:

To realise the value of one week: Ask an editor of a weekly newspaper.

To realise the value of one hour: Ask the friends who are waiting to meet.

To realise the value of one second: Ask the person who has escaped the accident.

To realise the value of one millisecond: Ask the person who has won a silver medal in the Olympics.

November offers many blessings. May we be more reflective in our living, may the Lord be merciful to the dying and may He grant life eternal to the dead.
