Dear Parishioners,

During the course of the coming year we will hear much about the 'Jubilee Year of Mercy' and hopefully we will come to appreciate the significance of what Pope Francis is offering the Church at this time so that we will experience in a very real and personal way the richness of God's mercy. The Year of Mercy was launched on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception (8th December 2015) with the opening of the Holy Door in St Peter's Basilica, Rome and will conclude on the Feast of Christ the King (13th November 2016).

Archbishop Eamon Martin has written a pastoral letter 'An Oasis of Mercy'; the full text is available on the parish website. He too will open a Holy Door in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh and in St Peter's Church, Drogheda.

From the very beginning of his papacy, Pope Francis has emphasised mercy and compassion. In his inaugural Mass on the feast of Saint Joseph (19th March 2013), he spoke about St Joseph, the protector of Mary and Joseph, as a strong and courageous man, a working man, and "yet in his heart we see great tenderness, which is not the virtue of the weak but rather a sign of strength of spirit and a capacity for concern. We must never be afraid of tenderness and mercy". Some months later Pope Francis said, "I see clearly that the thing the Church needs most today is the ability to heal wounds and to warm the hearts of the faithful. I dream of a Church that is a mother and shepherdess." Calling upon the Church's leaders to be "ministers of mercy above all", he went on to stress, "The Church's ministers must be merciful and compassionate and accompany people like the Good Samaritan, who washes, cleans and raises up his neighbour. This is pure Gospel." A short time later he declared to the Pontifical Council for Promoting the New Evangelisation (14th October 2013) the need to "use a language of mercy, which is expressed in gestures and attitudes even before words". And in his first apostolic exhortation 'The Joy of the Gospel' Pope Francis reiterated this point, "the Church must be a place of mercy freely given, where everyone can feel welcomed, loved, forgiven and encouraged to live the good life of the Gospel."

No wonder then – the 'Jubilee Year' will be a 'Year of Mercy'!
