**Annual Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock 2016**

The Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock will take place on **Sun 29 May.** In this Jubilee Year of Mercy Pope Francis has made a special request that Catholics should make a pilgrimage to a Holy Door or local shrine in their own country: "The practice of *pilgrimage* has a special place in the Holy Year, because it represents the journey each of us makes in this life. Life itself is a pilgrimage and the human being is a *viator*, a pilgrim travelling along the road." Buses are being arranged to leave from Dungannon on Sun 29 May.
