Dear Parishioners,

On this Sunday new things are celebrated: Christ's new commandment of love; the new Jerusalem emerging after the terrors of persecution; the fresh heart and encouragement given in the words of Paul and Barnabas. Recent weeks are full of new life and tender blossoms. New things are always exciting.

In today's second reading we hear the phrase, "Now I am making the whole of creation new." We don't often read the Apocalypse, the last book in the Bible, also called the Book of Revelations. It has the strangeness of a visionary text, filled with amazing imagery and populated with supernatural creatures. As a matter of curiosity, it would be interesting to find a New Testament and pick at random any section from the Apocalypse. You will find yourself transported in to a world that is undoubtedly extra terrestrial! While it is not meant to be taken literally, today's extract is offered to us during this post-Easter period for a purpose. It speaks of newness - everything is changed radically - there is a new heaven and a new earth. It speaks of the disappearance of the old earth, the overcoming of death, the wiping away of tears. There will be no more death, and no more mourning or sadness. The world of the past has gone. In the highly symbolic language of St John, it interprets what has happened through the death and resurrection of Jesus - we are offered new life and a new way of living. That new way of living is also captured in Christ's command: "Love one another; just as I have loved you, you also must love one another." His words are unequivocal. Be generous, nurture no grudges, act justly, love tenderly. Our love for each other is an expression of our love for God and it also gives us our Christian identity.

For some time the Parish Pastoral Council in conjunction with the Parish Liturgy Group has been considering how children could be better accommodated during the celebration of Sunday Mass. They have decided, as a pilot scheme, to offer children in Primary 3 an opportunity to withdraw from the Liturgy of the Word (10.30 am St Patrick's) and spend time reflecting on the Readings adapted to their age. Next Sunday someone will explain in detail what is entailed and outline the requirements in terms of registration, parental consent and other practicalities. It is hoped this initiative can be developed in due course to help families of children in other age groups.
