“Pope Francis has chosen Ireland to host the 9<sup>th</sup> World Meeting of Families during 2018. The dates and theme of the Meeting will be announced by Pope Francis himself.

The 9<sup>th</sup> World Meeting of Families is expected to attract thousands of Catholic families from around the globe to Ireland in 2018. It is hoped that this very special pastoral initiative will present all of us in the Church with the opportunity, and the challenge, to renew, support and strengthen Irish families in their commitment to their faith.

Hosting a global event of this size requires a huge amount of planning and financial outlay on behalf of the host country. To support the hosting of the event we intend to hold three national church collections, the first of which will take place on the weekend of 28-29 May. The World Meeting of Families was a pastoral initiative of St John Paul II. Held every three years, and coordinated by the Pontifical Council for the Family, it is the largest universal gathering of Catholic families and brings together families from all over the world in faith and celebration.
