Dear Friends in Christ,

In the last couple of days, we have celebrated two beautiful feasts in the life of the Church. On Friday we celebrated The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and on Saturday we celebrated The Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Heart of Jesus, the Heart of the Incarnate Son of God who took on flesh for our salvation. The heart is the seat of love and in the Heart of Jesus we see on one hand his great love for his Heavenly Father and His desire to do His will and at the same time His great love for us and His great desire that we will accept His great invitation of love to 'Come follow me.' (Mk 1:17.) As I read recently *Jesus wants followers not admirers.*

The powerful practice of the First Friday of the month, with people going to Mass and Holy Communion being brought to the sick and housebound comes from part of the apparitions of our Lord to St Margaret Mary Alacoque, "I promise you, in the excess of the mercy of My Heart, that Its all-powerful love will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the first Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under My displeasure nor without receiving the Sacraments, My Divine Heart becoming their assured refuge at that last hour." A powerful promise that we should all take advantage of.

Love desires love and our Lord's gentle complaint to St Margaret Mary in 1675 challenges us today in 2016 'Behold the Heart which has loved the world so much and received so little love in return.' A challenge to grow in our love and devotion for God each day after the example of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

In today's Gospel we see the raising of the widow's son at Nain. We see a glimpse of the love that Jesus has for his mother when He felt such great pity for this woman who lost her only son. Perhaps seeing in her a prefigurement to the great sorrow that his Mother would endure as she would watch both her Son and her Lord suffer and die on the Cross. We remember the great love that God and the Mother of God have for us and we rejoice!

I encourage you all to take part in our Corpus Christi Procession this evening (Sunday) as we process with the Blessed Sacrament, asking Him to bless us and our families. Please gather at St Patrick's College for 6pm prior to departure at 6.30pm. Adoration in St Patrick's College from 2.30pm-6.30pm. There is some limited parking at the College, however you may wish to park in the Church or Convent car parks and walk down to the College.
