I think it was John Milton who coined the phrase 'every cloud has a silver lining' - in this instance I am grateful for the opportunity to have additional time for prayer and reflection. I hope I will use it well to grow in my own relationship with the Lord and to commend to his care all of you and the many people who 'have made known to me the loving kindness of the heart of our God'.
