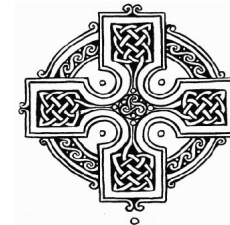

Dear Parishioners,

Today's first reading from the prophet Amos and the Gospel parable of Jesus are both concerned with the perennial gap between rich and poor, between those who are self-indulgent and those who are exploited. But the readings are also concerned with the terrible consequences of not being open to God's word, which is always a word of mercy. The rich man, Dives, was obviously a believer. He was familiar with the scriptures, but the message had not entered his heart. He was as wounded by his riches as the poor man, Lazarus, was wounded by his poverty. I've always liked Christy Kenneally's poems, especially the following one, which is not unrelated to the theme of today's readings:

Judgment Day

“Let me through, let me through, move away, stand aside.
You there, tell them I'm coming, and throw the gates wide.”
All the hurry and scurry, the racket and din,
As this man of importance went marching right in.
“You have lived in the world, you have walked many ways,
And the time has now come to account for your days”.
“Look, my shoes are the finest, on my fingers are rings
I have gathered through life, the most wonderful things.
I'm a man of importance, of course you can tell
But a mansion or two, Sir, will do me quite well”.
“But your feet are unmarked by the dust of the road,
And those hands, oh, so soft never helped with a load.
And that mouth always speaking of riches and gold
Never uttered a word, but was cruel and cold.
And a heart that has wanted to gather and own
Now has nothing, poor man, you have come here alone.
All these jewels and diamonds, these things you hold dear,
You can keep them forever, my friend, but not in here”.
And the man who had hoarded his love like a miser
Walked back through the gates, so much sadder and wiser.

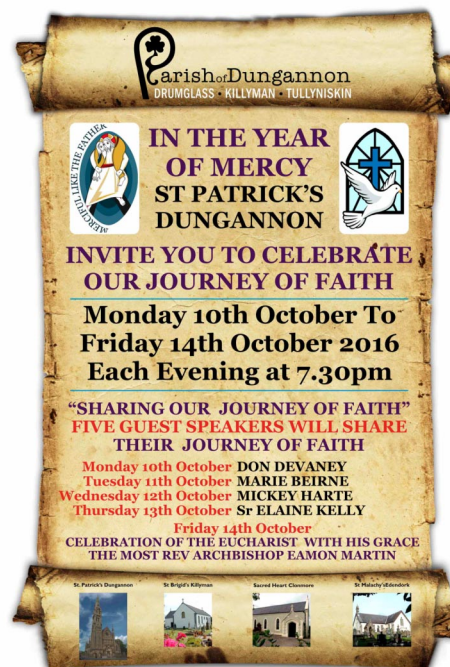
