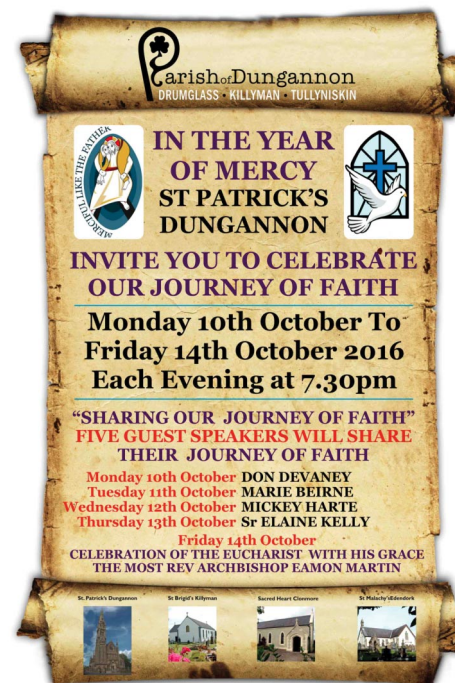
SACRED HEART CLONMORE
