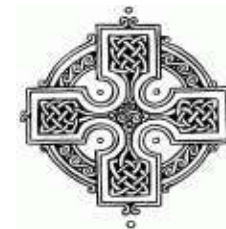

We are approaching the end of the Jubilee Year of Mercy – Sunday 20th November 2016. Archbishop Eamon Martin has asked parishes to promote a time of prayer within families on each evening during the coming week.

He writes, "Please gather whoever is at home on each evening after 6.00 pm for just a few moments and pray this short prayer together:

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, Holy Family of Nazareth, bless our family.

Keep anger and violence far from our door.

Whenever things are difficult, help us to overcome together the problems that come our way.

If you have Holy Water at home, ask each person present to make a Sign of the Cross on their forehead and pray for any special family intentions you might have. (You can get Holy Water at your local church). Finish by saying the Our Father together.

You are welcome to visit the Holy Door at the Cathedral in Armagh or at St Peter's Drogheda before the end of the Jubilee Year on 20th November. Please also consider coming as a family to Confession some time before Christmas.
