Dear Parishioners,

During the past year, designated by Pope Francis as a Jubilee Year of Mercy, we have been invited to reflect on God's compassion, we have been encouraged to experience God's mercy in a personal way by celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation and we have been asked to bring that mercy and compassion to other people, especially those who are oppressed and weighed down.

To quote Pope Francis: "If every one of us, every day, does a work of mercy, there will be a revolution in the world."
"In a world which has been damaged by the virus of indifference, the works of mercy are the best antidote".
"If you want to find God, seek him where he is hidden: in the neediest, the sick, the hungry, the imprisoned".

This week-end which is the last of the liturgical year, the Church celebrates the feast of Christ the King. This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 to combat the growing secularism and atheism of his time; it is one of the so-called "idea feasts" that do not celebrate an event in the life of Jesus but rather some aspect of his identity. In this feast we recognize and honour Christ as ruler and universal shepherd. Indeed, in Christ all of human history is summed up and fulfilled and, as the Second Vatican Council affirmed, "He is the key, the centre and the purpose of the whole of history . . ." The late John Denver recognised God's reign in his beautiful song, "Raven's Child". Check his introduction to this song recorded many years ago, but still very relevant. John derides the arrogance of this world's baron kings who control drugs, arms and oil; he then gives tribute to Jesus, the King of Kings, in these words:

"The true King sits on a heavenly throne, never away nor above nor apart,
With wisdom and mercy and constant compassion,
He lives in the love that lives in our hearts."
