Dear Parishioners

On the eve of his departure from this world Jesus bids farewell to his disciples who are frightened by the prospect of the loss of his leadership. Calming their anxiety, he tells them not to be troubled by his absence because he will go off to prepare a home for them in his Father's house. With words of consolation and of instruction he offers them a remedy for all their troubles. They are to have faith in God and confidence that God is looking after them. Jesus describes himself as one who leads the way to God the Father and he presents heaven as a spacious place with plenty of room for everybody.

The "many rooms" suggests an abundance of accommodation for many different kinds of people. Heaven is not an exclusive club admitting only those who were regarded as "very holy" in the course of their human lives. As Christians we view life as a pilgrimage to the house of the Father – a journey home. For some it's a rough passage, with inevitable sacrifices, sufferings and grief. For some there's little comfort and a lot of challenge: sickness in the family, difficult relationships, depression or unpaid bills. The list might well seem endless, but as we reach for the presence and power of Jesus we find encouragement and strength. If we can really accept the promise of Jesus and let His words sink into our minds: "Do not let your hearts be troubled" – a lot of the hustle and bustle can settle down in our lives.

The voice of Jesus is often a gentle whisper, best heard in quiet moments of prayer when we find a little time and space to experience the presence of God and to look with understanding at the past and with hope and confidence to the future. Then we will begin to know the peace and joy he meant us to have when he said, "Do not let your hearts be troubled".

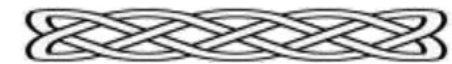
