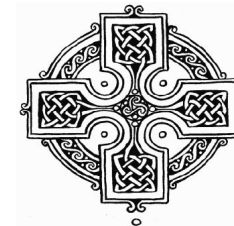

Dear Parishioners

Today's feast celebrates the birthday of the church because it was on the first Pentecost day that the infant church came into being and took on its mission to make Jesus and his life, work and message known to all the world. We read in Acts of the Apostles that while the apostles were at prayer in the room where, weeks earlier, they had shared the Last Supper with Jesus, there suddenly came a roaring wind and the Holy Spirit descended upon them in the form of tongues of fire. Their doubts and fears were lifted away and they were transformed into men of courage who went out to tell the world about the amazing deeds that God had done through Jesus and about God's plan for the salvation of all peoples. The early church was born. Ever since, the Holy Spirit has been a permanent presence and a tower of strength in guiding and directing the church and its members.

The work of the Holy Spirit continues in our own time as God seeks to share his divine nature with us, thus preparing us to share eternal life with him. Regular prayer keeps that channel of communication open and flowing – remember the Holy Spirit first came to the apostles while they were praying and Jesus often went off to pray to draw upon the power of God so as to sustain and continue the work he was doing for God. Do not underestimate the value and importance God places on the work that you and I are doing for God. Empowered by God, strengthened and guided by the Holy Spirit and fed by the word and sacrament of Jesus, we are part of the mission that began at the first Pentecost to bring God's Good News of hope and salvation, love and mercy, justice and peace to our world today.
