Dear Parishioners

On the feast of the Most Holy Trinity we come face to face with the inner mystery of God as a family of persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, where there is complete harmony, love and total peace. It is worth reminding ourselves that scripture tells us that we are children of God the father who cares for us, that in Jesus Christ we have a brother who died for us and that in the Holy Spirit we have a friend who strengthens, guides and protects us.
