Dear Parishioners

Peter must surely rate as one of the most interesting characters in the gospels. Jesus chose him to be the leader of the new Christian community and yet in many ways he turned out to be unpredictable and even unreliable. Recall how he became so hot-headed when Jesus was arrested that he drew his sword and cut off a soldier's ear. Sometime later, when taunted by a servant in Pilate's courtyard, Peter was so weak that he denied even knowing Jesus.

Yet Jesus did appoint him as leader, showing confidence in him and entrusting him with continuing the work that Jesus had begun. The choice of the all-too-human Peter as leader of the church is an example of the power of God at work – empowering the weak and calling us forward to a greater destiny. Peter had a deep-seated trust in the person of Jesus which more than compensated for any human weakness. Peter invites, even challenges, each of us to show similar trust in Jesus so that we can live our lives to the full, and so that the power of Jesus can always be at work in us and through us.

Lord, deepen our faith and strengthen our trust.
