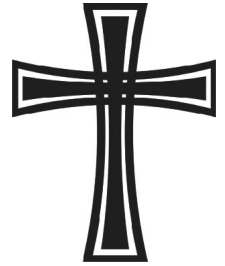

Dear Parishioners

The readings carry a very clear message concerning our responsibility towards the salvation of others within the community. No-one is an island and in Christ we are all brothers and sisters, members of the one family.
