Dear Parishioners,

It may seem odd that John the Baptist, urging sinners to repent and be baptised, is approached by Jesus who requests to be put through the same baptism. But, by entering the waters of the river Jordan, Jesus chose purposely to put himself on the side of sinners and to take on the burden of our sins. He came on this earth to share fully our way of life and to die that we might live forever. This first act of his public ministry was one of humility – it launched his mission of loving service to all. The voice from heaven was the announcement that Jesus truly was the long-awaited Saviour of the world. The baptism of Jesus was not an isolated event but rather the beginning of a mission. So too for each of us – our baptism was not a distant childhood event but rather a lasting relationship with Jesus. Baptism is a great honour and a great calling – we are drawn into the family of God and we are called to take responsibility for making our world a better place. We will do this, most likely, not on some grand scale, but rather “in the bits and pieces of everyday life”.

Lord, keep us alert to ways we may live out our baptismal calling, not just in prayer and worship, but in acts of kindness to those with whom we share our lives and maybe also to complete strangers.
