Dear Parishioners

In the first reading, Abraham's faith and trust is an example to all of us. In the gospel Jesus and the disciples experience the high drama of the transfiguration and hear the heavenly voice announce, "This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him". No wonder then, that in the presence of such divine glory, Peter declared, "It is wonderful for us to be here". Of course, it was wonderful to realise that they were in heavenly company and to hear powerful confirmation that their decision to follow Jesus had been exactly the right thing to do. There could be no doubt any longer – Jesus was the one they had been waiting for and now he was in their midst, teaching and healing and bringing his followers to God.

Then reality bites and it's time to go back down the mountain, into the normal and usual run of life with all its ups and downs. The disciples faithfully observed the command of Jesus that they should tell no-one about their experience just yet. He knew that his mission was not yet complete and that the glimpse of heaven was a foresight, a promise of what lay beyond the cross of Calvary. The memory of this event may well have sustained the disciples who witnessed it through the harsh days of the passion and death of Jesus. Then when Jesus rose from the dead the disciples would have connected all these events together – so they went out full of faith and confidence, full of enthusiasm and joy, to tell all the world about the love of God made visible and powerful in Christ Jesus our Lord. As we reflect of these readings today may our faith be strengthened and may our trust in God be ever more sure.
