Dear Parishioners

At this time of year we see the miracle of growth taking place all around us in flowers, grass, plants and shrubs. We don't have to be professional gardeners to realise that growth is a gradual process that requires time, tender care and constant patience before flower and fruit are produced. Today's readings are concerned with growth – not physical but spiritual growth. They speak of the importance of us coming to God in prayer and good works in order to grow in God's favour and friendship. The seed of God's presence within us was first planted at our baptism. Our task is to look after it so that it can work powerfully within us, making a difference in our own lives and through us, in the lives of others.

The mustard seed and tree remind us that the seed of God's presence within us grows slowly: we may even feel frustrated at times that we seem to make little progress in becoming better people. Yet God does not wait for us to be excellent – he rewards our efforts and our desire to keep trying. God's grace and blessing may well be most at work when we are deeply conscious of our human weaknesses and limitations. May God keep us alert to opportunities where we can carry out good works and acts of loving kindness – evidence that the seed of God's presence planted within us is beginning to produce the fruit that God waits for.
