Dear Parishioners

The Pharisees frequently clashed with Jesus over what constituted true worship of God. Jesus told them that they had missed the whole point of religion – which is to show love for God in prayer and worship and to show love for neighbour by the way we treat people. The Pharisees had made external observance and outward show the supreme test of goodness and even of holiness – Jesus told them their worship had sunk to the level of mere lip-service. Their worship was worthless, nothing more than a set of pious-looking acts.

Jesus is pointing out something that he wants us to notice. His challenge to the Pharisees may apply to us as well. Jesus is appealing to us to be on our guard against merely external compliance with ritual or regulation. He is telling us that while we look to appearances, God looks to the heart and cannot be deceived. He is demanding that out innermost thoughts as well as our outward actions stand up to God's scrutiny. We need to be continually pondering what God wants of us, how our faith is put into practice. Jesus is delighted that we receive Him in Holy Communion, provided we then strive to become ever more Christ-like in our daily lives. Our prayer and worship must lead to kindness and care, especially for the weak and the vulnerable, following the example of Jesus himself.
