Dear Parishioners

The gospel tells how Jesus cured a man who was deaf and had a speech impediment. We see the trouble Jesus went to on behalf of this poor man: he took him away from the crowd so that he could deal with him in private and give him his undivided attention. By physically placing his fingers in the man's ears Jesus opened them to hear. When Jesus walked this earth, people believed that the spittle of a holy person, gently placed on another person's ailment, had healing powers, so it was entirely appropriate to use the spittle in this way. Jesus raised his eyes to heaven to show the man that it was from God that the help and healing came.

Most of us are neither deaf nor dumb, yet everybody has certain impediments that prevent them from making full use of the gifts of healing and speech. Some people are poor listeners, and some people have difficulty in expressing themselves. Jesus healed the man and then took him a stage further – he enabled him to hear the word of God and then to profess his faith in Jesus.

We too need to be able to hear the word of God. Then we need to be able and willing to profess our faith with our lips. Finally, we need to be committed to putting our faith into practice in our lives by being all that God has called us to be.
