Dear Parishioners

The gospels tell us of many occasions when Jesus sent his disciples out to proclaim God's Good News of hope and salvation and to welcome people to faith in God. In Matthew's gospel, the closing lines tell of Jesus, after his resurrection, instructing his disciples, "Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that I am with you always, yes to the end of time". So it is entirely appropriate that we continue the missionary activity begun by Jesus, that we support it by prayer and by practical help – and that we trust the promise of Jesus to be with us in our efforts, right to the end of time.

Ireland has a long tradition in passing on the faith to the wider world. Many regions of modern Europe attribute their Christian faith to the work of Irish monks and they still celebrate their link to the "island of saints and scholars". In more recent centuries, Irish priests and sisters shared the faith with Africa, the Americas and the Far East. Many from our own parish and neighbouring parishes were among them over the years and some are still on mission there today – we think of them and pray for them, we thank God for the great work they do and we commit to support them as best we can. In that way we can each be at least a small part of the missionary team first formed by Jesus, the team that he has promised to stay with to the end of time.
