Dear Parishioners

The fact that we have our eyesight does not mean that we always see what is most important in life. There is more to sight than just seeing the light of day. The light of life, and the light of spiritual life, makes a real difference for us as well. We may at times go through spiritual darkness, sorely in need of Jesus, the light of the world. In caring for blind Bartimaeus, Jesus is telling us that there is an even worse state of blindness than physical blindness – Jesus wants to heal us all and lead us into the light of faith.

There are so many ways that our spiritual sight can be damaged. Pride and jealousy can prevent us from seeing goodness in our neighbours. Being unfair to others may be caused by our blindness to a sense of justice. Never being satisfied with what we have and always wanting more material goods may indicate that we are blinded by greed. By prayer and trust in Jesus, who is the light of the world, may both our physical and our spiritual eyesight be strong so that we can see what we should be doing to let the light of Jesus shine out from each one of us, so that together we create an abundance of light that brings blessing and benefit to all.
