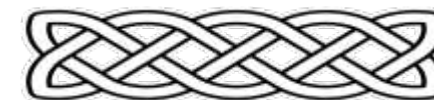

INDULGENCES FOR HOLY SOULS

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions – which are - On any given day between November 1 to 8: (a) have the attitude of detachment from all sin, including venial sin (b) devoutly visit a graveyard and pray for the departed, (c) sacramental confession (a week before or after) (d) receive Holy Communion (a week before or after) (e) pray for the intentions of the Pope (Our Father and Hail Mary) If you wish to receive more than one plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory, then numbers a,b,d,e must be fulfilled each day.
