1st Sunday of Advent

2 December 2018

Dear Parishioners,

The Season of Advent has two key characteristics: it is a time of preparation for celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ and it is also a reminder of his second coming, in glory, at the end of time. The readings contain some valuable reminders that we must be ready and prepared for our personal meeting with the Lord on judgement day. Our future very much depends on the way we are living at this moment. We are the authors and planners of our own eternal destiny.

As people of faith we celebrate in every Mass the presence of Jesus Christ among us until he comes in glory. In word and sacrament Jesus seeks to prepare us for our day of judgement, just as in today's gospel he cautions his disciples – and us as well – to be vigilant by constantly ensuring that we are ready and worthy to meet him. He expects that his presence among us makes a positive difference to how we live our lives – and he invites us to examine ourselves and consider to what extent our lives reflect the influence Jesus has had on us.

Advent calls us once more to a fresh start in building a closer relationship with Jesus Christ. Prayer, penance and acts of charity and kindness are worthy preparations for the coming of the Lord. Advent provides an opportunity to pause and take a look at ourselves, to see what needs to be put right, to reflect on God's great love for us and to respond to that love by lives of Christian service.
