**Fourth Sunday of the Year**

**3 February 2019**

Dear Parishioners,

Today's gospel tells of the harsh reception Jesus experienced in his home town of Nazareth – he barely escaped with his life and, going by the gospel of Luke, he never went back there again. The way Jesus was treated was in sharp contrast to the love that St Paul recommends in today's second reading: "Love is always patient and kind... never jealous...never rude or selfish.... takes no pleasure in other people's sins... is always ready to excuse, to trust, to hope and to endure whatever comes". Jesus displayed a quality of love "to endure whatever comes" all through his entire mission and ministry. If love is always patient and kind, it has to face impatience and unkindness. If love is always ready to excuse, it has to face those who are all-too-ready to condemn. If love takes no pleasure in other people's sins, then it has to face those who delight in the weaknesses of others.

Love is a tough and demanding calling. But we do well to follow and imitate the example and style of Jesus and let his forgiving, tolerating, healing, empowering and saving love be our way too. We keep in mind those thoughtful words of St Paul: "There are three things that last, faith, hope and love and the greatest of these is love".
