Eighth Sunday of the Year

3 March 2019

Dear Parishioners,

The theme of last week's gospel continues today: treat people with decency and fairness, show compassion, avoid condemnation and judgement - and realise that what you measure out is what you will be given back when your own day of judgement arrives.

Jesus was often placed in seemingly awkward situations where he was challenged by self-righteous people to pass harsh judgement on unfortunate individuals. He always steered away and even had a solid answer for the accusers, such as "let him who is without sin cast the first stone". Jesus used words to heal and to restore, to bring back life, joy and hope. He chose to encourage and support, to bless and to build. In today's gospel Jesus proposes that we attend to our own faults and flaws rather than broadcasting our opinions about the faults of others. The season of Lent presents us with a great opportunity to reflect on what needs to change in our lives and to ask for God's grace as we try to become better people.
