Fourth Sunday of Lent

31 March 2019

Dear Parishioners,

A Bible scholar once said that if Jesus had been given only three minutes instead of three years for his ministry in this world, he would have told his parable of the merciful father and the self-centred sons. The younger son tells us something about greed – but also about the virtues of humility and repentance. The older son displays the weakness of human nature and how easily jealousy and resentment can arise in us when we see other people treated well or with compassion. The star of the story is the father who welcomes his son home without a word of condemnation or anger. His son is still his son, the father's love never changes. Here Jesus gives us an insight to the gracious goodness of God. His love for us is constant, he is always ready to forgive and to welcome us back.

This famous parable of Jesus is drawn from real life and if we are honest we can see shades of both the elder and the younger sons in ourselves. We have all been wandering, disobedient and selfish children who hold grudges and are unwilling to forgive one another. We have at times forgotten our ever-loving father who even after our most stupid mistakes and foolish sins is always ready to receive us with open arms. This gospel tells us what coming back to God is really like: a fresh start, new hope and kindly encouragement.
