Fifth Sunday of Lent

Dear Parishioners,

Forgiveness is not an easy action, not a simple process, not something we rush to offer. As in today's gospel, our self-righteousness can make us all-too-ready to condemn and to criticise. Jesus frequently found himself in situations where he needed to challenge and confront the self-righteous and where he needed to rescue and restore the condemned, People can be quick exclude others and to set them apart. The mission and ministry of Jesus, and therefore our task as his followers, was very often about inclusion through reconciliation, restoring relationships by a process of understanding and forgiveness. By his ministry to those on the margins Jesus welcomed people back and restored them to full membership of the community. Jesus did not condemn. Neither should we. Jesus forgave. So should we.

As we prepare to celebrate the great sacrifice of Jesus by which he won for each of us forgiveness from God and a place in God's plan of salvation, let us conduct ourselves in ways that make us worthy to be called followers of Jesus.
