Palm Sunday

Dear Parishioners,

Jesus shows us the ways of compassion, mercy and love even as he is being nailed to the cross. He prays "Father, forgive them; they do not know what they are doing". In his own physical pain and suffering the concern of Jesus is more for the spiritual welfare of his executioners. He conveys the lesson that no physical pain can compare to the spiritual agony of being far from God. Most of our Sunday gospels this year come from the gospel of Luke, who gives us the parables of the Lost Sheep, the Lost Coin and the Lost (prodigal) Son. The common feature and message of these parables is that God never stops seeking the lost. Neither does Jesus, and so even on the cross he finds one more lost soul – the thief who asks for forgiveness and is promised a place with Jesus in paradise. May we be drawn into the company and manner of Jesus in the way of the cross: the ways of generosity, non-violence, compassion, mercy and love.
