Third Sunday of Easter

5 May 2019

Dear Parishioners,

Between his resurrection from the dead and his ascension into heaven Jesus presented himself to his disciples on several occasions. Thus he enabled and encouraged the disciples to realise and accept the reality of the resurrection and to reflect on all that Jesus had said and done in the course of his public ministry.
