The Ascension of the Lord

2 June 2019

Dear Parishioners

The first reading and the gospel for today tell the same story, by the same author, but with slightly different details. Both contain the central theme of witness. Jesus tells the disciples in the Gospel of Luke "You are witnesses to this". In the Acts of the Apostles (which was written by the same Luke who wrote the Gospel), Jesus instructs the disciples "You will be my witnesses not only in Jerusalem but throughout Judaea and Samaria, and indeed to the ends of the earth". A witness is someone who has seen an event and gives testimony about it, for the disciples it is not enough that they have been the first-hand witnesses to the ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus - they used the "power from on high" that comes through the Holy Spirit so that they can carry out the mission that Jesus had set for them.

As they went out to be witnesses for Jesus one of the great hallmarks of those early disciples was that they were "full of joy" - as recorded in the final sentence of the gospel today. The more we appreciate all that God has done for us through Jesus and the more we allow the Holy Spirit to influence and empower us, the more we too will be filled with joy and goodness that then overflows into love and care for those with whom we share our lives and our world.
