Trinity Sunday

16 June 2019

Dear Parishioners

Today's feast reminds us of a simple truth that we maybe do not often reflect upon – God's plan is that we share in his life of glory. By our baptism we are raised to a level at which we become sharers in the family life of God. We are born of God the Father, God the Son becomes our brother and the love of God is poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit. This revelation of his inner life of three persons, in which we have a share, is one of God's greatest gifts to us and it is the model towards which we are invited to aim and to prepare ourselves to be ready to join.

Jesus reveals the mystery of the Trinity to us, not just to let us know the truth about God, but also to know the truth about ourselves – as to what is our origin, where is our destiny and how we can arrive at that final point. We only exist, and the world only exists, because God gives life. He is the Father who looks upon us as his children and is closer to us that we are to ourselves. Love is the binding force of the three persons of the Trinity – so when we love, when we care, we share in that community of love and care which is the living God. Let us respond with enthusiasm to the high status God has given us by placing us within the loving embrace of the Trinity.
