Dear Parishioners

As we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ we might expect that the readings would include the account of the Last Supper. Instead we have Luke's account of the multiplication of the loaves. We might notice that the same verbs are used at both of the above events:

Jesus took the bread

Jesus blessed the bread

Jesus broke the bread

Jesus gave the bread

Jesus is food not just for the twelve but for the thousands, for all his believers. We might recall too that in Luke's gospel Jesus enters the world lying in a "manger" - a trough from which farm animals could eat. In the final chapter of Luke's gospel the disciples on the road to Emmaus came to recognise Jesus in the breaking of the bread. In the Acts of the Apostles, chapter 27:35, Luke tells of Paul the apostle celebrating a meal with the breaking of bread. So the origin of the eucharist is not confined to the Last Supper - it permeates the gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles which Luke also wrote. Today's gospel makes clear that when Jesus sees his people in need he looks after them with reckless generosity and abundance.
