All through the Bible, both Old and New Testaments, is a consoling and reassuring message of the mercy and forgiveness of God towards sinners. The message seeks to tell us that we are in a family relationship with God whose kindness is beyond words. He welcomes his wayward children home and treats them as if they had never strayed. God's eagerness to forgive must surely touch, console and give hope to sinners. Jesus wants us to know that even after our most stupid mistakes and tragic sins he will be looking to take us back with open arms and restore us to his love, because God is tireless in seeking out sinners.
