Dear Parishioners,

The Christian way of life often calls us to be in contrast with the usual norms, standards and structures of the world. We do not need to look far in our world to see those who promote and exalt themselves. Indeed we are all likely, if we are honest, to slip into the style and manner of the Pharisee in today's gospel. Jesus suggests that we would be better to identify with the tax collector and to present ourselves in a state of humility before God and before those with whom we share our lives. Let us recall that when Mary welcomed God's call to bring Jesus into the world her prayer included the statement that God "brings down princes from their thrones, but raises up the lowly". (Luke 1:52) Jesus himself was to go through experiences of humility – misunderstood, rejected, falsely accused, ill-treated, tortured, crucified – before being raised up to eternal glory. The hardships we bear unite us with the person of Jesus. We approach God in prayers, asking forgiveness for our faults and asking help as we face the challenges of life. "God be merciful to me, a sinner".
