Dear Parishioners,

The encounter between Jesus and Zacchaeus displays God's boundless love for sinners. It shows the forgiveness he offers to the worst of us. Zacchaeus was hated by the community – he was a cheat and a tax collector for the Roman forces of occupation. People would have had him written off as lost. Yet, Jesus made him feel special, accepted, welcomed. Jesus saw beyond the greedy little man so as to recognise the pain and turmoil in his heart. His wealth had not made him happy and what little he knew about Jesus stirred his conscience as well as his deep religious impulse – he was, after all, as Jesus said, a "son of Abraham".

Jesus shows that no-one is beyond salvation, everyone can be brought back into the fold. There is no past, however shameful, that cannot be given a fresh start.

The call of Jesus, "Hurry, because I must stay at your house today" goes out to every one of us. He invites us to acknowledge our sins and open our hearts to his goodness. Then, like Zacchaeus, we will be motivated and inspired to share that goodness with others, especially those we have wronged in any way. None of us is beyond the need of God's mercy and all of us can be transformed when, like Zacchaeus, we welcome Jesus joyfully and leave our old ways behind so as to experience true happiness.
