Second Sunday of Lent 8 March 2020



Dear Parishioners,

Today's gospel tells us of Jesus and his disciples going "up a high mountain where they could be alone". In the peace and tranquillity of the mountain top they shared an amazing, divine experience and the presence of God. Jesus went up there to seek divine guidance in quiet prayer and to enable his disciples to get a sense of a power beyond themselves. At first they were overcome with fear, so Jesus – came to them – he touched them – he said to them – "Stand up – do not be afraid". In that way, Jesus empowered them for their future roles in carrying on his mission. He showed them that time spent in quiet prayer would help them see the realities and even the difficulties of life through the eyes of God. He allowed them to see a vision of future glory yet cautioned them that suffering and death would be stages on the journey to that future glory.

We are all on the road to Calvary and we are constantly tested by disappointments and trials on the way. But Jesus promises a heavenly future to all who are willing to share the journey with him as faithful disciples. Jesus is with us on the journey towards God and the Holy Spirit gives us strength especially at the times when – like Jesus and the disciples in today's gospel – we actually feel we are alone.
