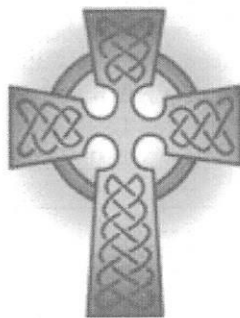

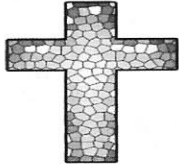
MASS
